The Celtic Kennel is located on the NE side of the Fairgrounds. This is the only way you can enter with a dog. The area is a metal covered arena. You are welcome to bring tarps to lie down on the ground as it is a horse arena. Water is available.

This is an opportunity to educate the public about our beloved breed. We can tell people that they make perfect family dogs, need regular grooming and are an energetic breed. Take a moment to read up on the history of the Scottish Terrier which you can find on our website. www.wsstc.org People will ask a lot of questions and children will want to pet all the dogs.

All dogs should have a rabies vaccination as they will be in demand by the public for petting. If you are bringing dogs that can't be petted please set them in an X-pen or crate towards the back by the fence. We understand that households with multiple pets need to travel together. This is also a good area to place your dogs that need a break from the public.

Please bring chairs, crates, x-pens, poop bags, water or coolers. Flexi-leads are discouraged as they get tangle in other pet's leashes which can lead to fights. Ask someone to watch your dogs while you take some time to walk around the Fairgrounds.
