There are five types of membership open to all persons who subscribe to the purposes of this club and are in good standing with AKC. The application will be submitted to the Membership Chair and read at the first meeting of the Club following its receipt. Before the application can be voted upon, the applicant must attend at least two General Membership meetings or one General Membership meeting and one Club event. Attendance at General Membership meetings or Club events, up to six months before application is made, will be considered to have met this requirement. If this requirement is not met within six months of filing the application, the application becomes void. An affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members present and voting shall be required to elect the applicant to membership. Applicants for membership who have been rejected by the Club may not re-apply within six months of such rejection.

A. REGULAR MEMBERS. Membership shall be open to any person eighteen (18) years of age or older, who is interested in or owner of a Scottish Terrier, who subscribes to the purposes of the Club, and who has submitted an application and been elected in accordance with Section 3 hereof.

B. ASSOCIATE MEMBERS. Membership shall be open to any person eighteen (18) years of age or older, who is interested in or owner of a Scottish Terrier, who subscribes to the purposes of the Club, and who has submitted an application and been elected in accordance with Section 3 hereof. Associate members will receive the Club's newsletter but do not have the privilege of voting, running for office or sponsoring new members. Associate members' dues are at a reduced rate. An associate can upgrade their membership to Regular membership status at the beginning of the Club's fiscal year.

C. FAMILY MEMBERSHIP. Membership shall be open to any two persons eighteen (18) years of age, living in the same household, who are interested in or owners of a Scottish Terrier, who subscribes to the purposes of the Club, and who has submitted an application and been elected in accordance with Section 3 hereof. Each member shall have one (1) vote in all club affairs.

D. JUNIOR MEMBERS. Junior membership shall be open to any person from ten (10) through seventeen (17) years of age. Junior Members may not vote, hold office, or sponsor new members. Prospective Junior Members must submit an application and be elected in accordance with Section 3 hereof. Junior Members automatically convert to Regular Members on their eighteenth birthday.

E. LIFETIME MEMBERS. Shall be open to individuals who have performed outstanding service to the betterment of the Club and of the Breed for at least 25 years. The Board of Directors may nominate a person for Lifetime Membership at a meeting of the Board. This nomination shall be presented at the next general meeting of the Club where a majority vote of the members present and voting will elect the nominee to the Lifetime Membership. A Lifetime member shall have all rights and privileges of regular membership, but pay no dues. A Regular member may make a recommendation for a nominee to the Board with substantiating information.

Dues must accompany the application.
