Whether you are just getting started in grooming, been grooming for years or need to perfect some skills, we promise you will learn something and go home glad you came. We will have a short General Club meeting just before we get the seminar underway.

We will start the day off with a hands-on stripping demonstration. We will have dogs that you can practice on, so when you go away, you will know the feel of a coat that is ready to come out, how to thin out the undercoat and what it feels like when the hairs are plucked.

Next on the agenda will be our "Share and Tell". We would like to encourage you to bring your favorite grooming product or tool/s that you love to use to share with the group.

After lunch (which is included in the price of the seminar), there will be 4 stations set up showing grooming on specific areas of our Scotties. You can watch or participate in any station as many times as you feel the need to become proficient in the proper grooming of that specific area. We all have areas that give us trouble and sometimes it just takes repetition to get it perfected!! During the course of the day, you will also have a chance to purchase a great grooming manual or pick up a product or tool that you would like to try.



This is a seminar for all levels of grooming skill, so we invite you to join in. Grooming is an art that takes practice and patience. Once you learn to "Tame Your Beastie" with the skills you will learn at this seminar, maintaining a great coat and having a properly groomed Scottie will be one more achievement you can add to your inventory of being an accomplished Scottie owner.

Please bring your dog bathed and brushed, ready to be practiced on.

Also bring any grooming tools that you use and your table, if you want to practice on your own.

We will have tables for each station, so it is not totally necessary that you have a table.

You will need an ex-pen or crate for quiet time, and all the other essentials to make your dog and your self comfortable for the day, like water, shade, and a chair.

DIRECTIONS:

From I-5 North, take Exit 105, bear right and take the Port of Olympia Exit onto Plum Street. Keep straight on Plum until it becomes East Bay Drive. (it's a straight shot). You will pass Priest Point Park. Just after the 40 mile zone, turn RIGHT on 36th Street. Go through the first 4-way stop sign. Harrington Lane is on the LEFT (large sign). The Kennel is the first LEFT and there's a sign with an Airedale on it.

From I-5 South, take Exit 105 and bear right onto Henderson Avenue. Continue to the stop light and turn left onto Plum Street. Continue straight until Plum becomes East Bay Drive. Continue straight past Priest Point Park to 36th Avenue. Turn right onto 36th street. Go straight through the 4-way stop and turn left onto Harrington lane. The kennel is the first left and there's a sign with an Airedale on it.
